

# Regional open university education and lifelong learning

- The Finnish Universities Act (558/2009) provides that universities must promote lifelong learning by degree-awarding, continuing, or by open university education.
- Open university education is provided at 14 Finnish universities. (<u>Finland</u>)
- Open universities are integral parts of their universities, and they can also operate regionally.
- The objective is to offer everyone opportunities to develop their competences, to raise their level of education and to receive retraining.


# Open University of the University of Jyväskylä

- Open University is an independent institute that operates in cooperation with the University's faculties.
- It is in charge of organizing and developing university education that promotes educational equality and lifelong learning.
- The education is provided either as the University's own instruction or in cooperation with currently around 60 regional partner institutions located in various parts of Finland. (Finland)
- These partners are providing also other types of adult education than open university education.


## Number of students registered to studies in counties in 2014



The grand total of 15 977 of which students at the open university 13 383 and at the partner institutions 2 594 • = partner institution (around 60)

## Quality management procedures in collaboration

- Teachers and tutors: predetermined qualifications & approval
- Co-operation agreements
- Website for partner institutions
- Seminar once a year
- Co-operation visits to partner institutions
- Co-operation during the academic year
- Student feedback-system: e-system when applying the certificate, total results of last year on the web-page → developing the OU studies
- Pedagogical laboratory: developing adult educational and elearning practices in the University of Jyväskylä
